

# Marion Recreation Youth Sailing Lessons

For children going into grades 4-8



## Classes will run in July and August

The instructor will call you to set up class times.

The Marion Recreation Committee is pleased to offer beginner sailing lessons. You don't need to know anything about boats to participate. The goal of this program is to make sure that every Marion child who wants to sail, can.

You will be given eight lessons over a two week period aboard a 15' Bullseye which will sail around Sippican Harbor and have two or three students and the instructor, Chris Kostyla, on board. Chris has taught for several years in local programs and sailed for the University of North Carolina. Classes will be held on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays mornings. Students will be taught about boat safety and knot tying as well as sailing and rowing. In the event of dangerous weather, the instructor will try to reschedule. Classes will run for one and a half hours. You may sign up with a friend if you wish.

All sailors must demonstrate an ability to swim in a competent manner for 100 yards fully clothed. Please see Silvershell lifeguard Bridget for your swimming test.

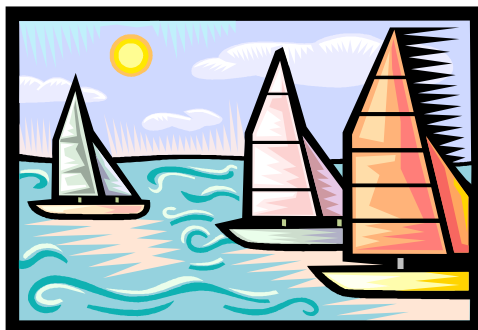
Participants must wear a PFD (personal floatation device) from the time he/she stops on the dock until he/she is once again on solid ground.

The actual cost of the sailing lessons is over \$120 per pupil. That does not include the value of the work donated by volunteers and Burr Bros. Boat Yard. In order to accommodate all interested children, there is a sliding fee schedule. Please choose the fee which is most appropriate for you **\$75, \$100 or \$120**. Additional scholarships are available; please call 748-2310 for details.

Sailing classes will meet at Island Wharf, which is the pier near the Band Stand. Classes will start promptly and students will be returned to the dock at the end of the lesson; the instructor will not wait for parents to pick up their children.

We will sail if it is raining, be prepared to get wet. All sailors must wear a good fitting lifejacket, closed toe shoes, sunscreen and bring along sunglasses, water bottle and hat.
